COPYRIGHT is national

generally protected
SCIENTIFIC
TEXTS, ABSTRACTS
& ILLUSTRATIONS

WHO is the author? **ALL RIGHTS** belong to the author

Exceptions:

- several authors
- work fulfilled under direction
- special publishing agreements

Moral Rights

protection of author's personal relationship to his work

- Time & Place of publication
- Attribution
- Prevent Disguise



Economic Exploitation

- copy
- distribute
- exhibition
- public presentation



COPYRIGHT: NON-TRANSFERRABLE in GERMANY
LICENCE-CONTRACTS are bilateral agreements in ALL COUNTRIES

TYPES OF RIGHTS

- ▲ exclusive
- ▲ non-exclusive

CONTRACT

Should exist in WRITTEN form (not e-mail)

- title
- granted rights
- limitations of time, place, use
- no responsibility for violation of third party rights
