Some trends...

❖ Modern/ post-92 institutions (Oxford Brookes, Coventry, Hull and Northumbria)

- Small but growing research bases whose ambition is not met by the RCUK block grant allocation

❖ Publisher engagement- (RLUK subgroup)

- How publishers' submission and publication process is integrated with OA procedures
- How HEI's metadata needs can be better met by publishers
- What HEIs and publishers can do better together to support researchers

❖ Cost management (Bath)

- APC process management- UCL released their database
- Issue of admin cost overheads- London Higher/ SPARC: 'Counting the costs of OA' report

- ~~Off setting schemes- how they are evaluated and embedded into workflows~~



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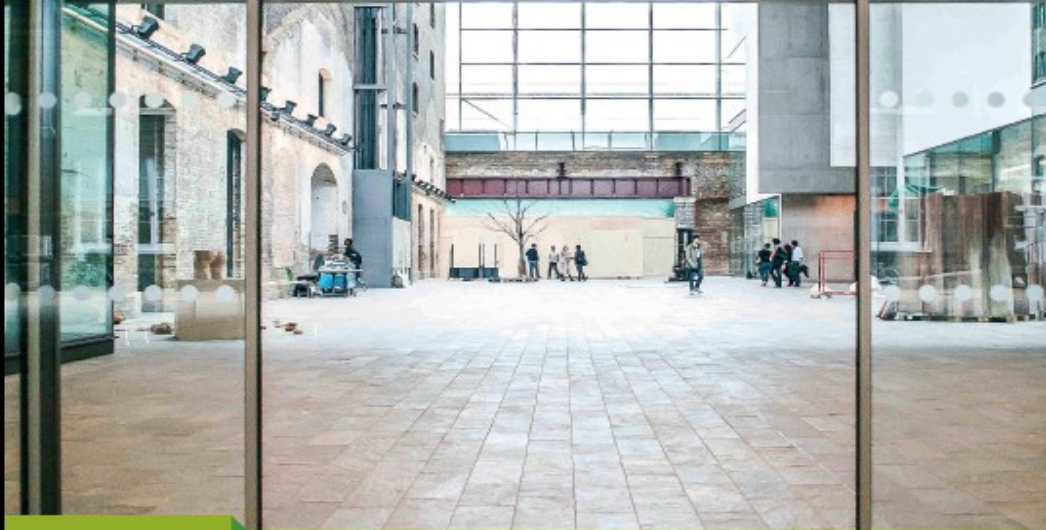
Some trends...



- ❖ Role of region/ locality to support OA implementation- (Manchester openWorks project)
 - Range of institutions across NW with differing size of research base and human/ financial
 - Creating a NW 'community of practice'
- ❖ Technical enhancements (Glasgow E2EOA, Edinburgh LOCH)
 - Defining and creating specification for improved metadata management-potential fields necessary for RCUK and REF compliance for Eprints
