





Facilitate Open Science Training for European Research

- **Support different stakeholders**, especially young researchers, in adopting open access in the context of the European Research Area (ERA) and in complying with the open access policies and rules of participation set out for Horizon 2020;
- **Integrate open access principles and practice in the current research workflow** by targeting the young researcher training environment;
- **Strengthen the institutional training capacity** to foster compliance with the open access policies of the ERA and Horizon 2020 (beyond the FOSTER project);
- **Facilitate the adoption, reinforcement and implementation of open access policies** from other European funders, in line with the EC's recommendation, in partnership with PASTEUR40A project.

- Identifying already existing contents that can be reused in the context of the training activities and repackaging, reformatting them to be used within FOSTER, and develop/create/ enhance contents if/where they are needed.
- Creation of the FOSTER Portal to support e-learning, blended learning, self-learning, dissemination of training materials/contents and Helpdesk.
- Delivery of face-to-face training, especially training trainers/multipliers that can carry on further training and dissemination activities, within their institutions, countries or disciplinary communities.

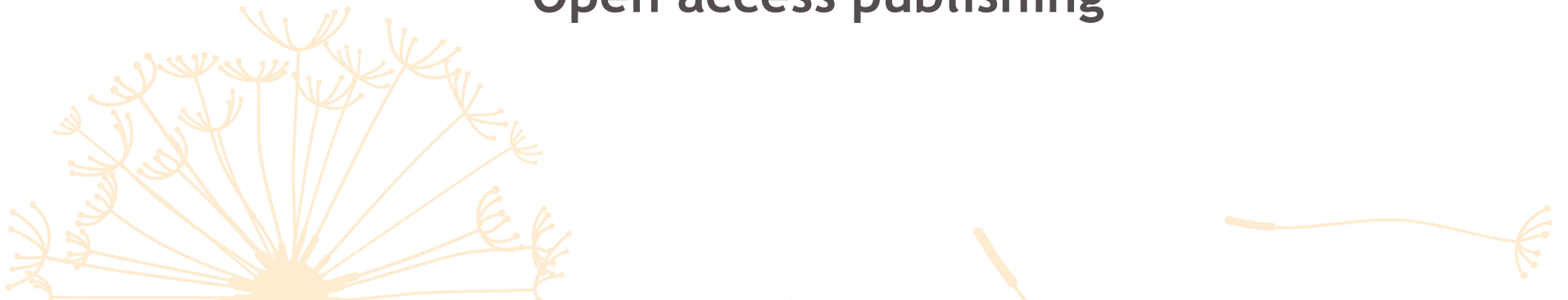

ensures open access via the repository within six months of publication (12 months for publications in the social sciences & humanities)

deposits as soon as possible and at the latest on publication, if an electronic version is available for free via the publisher

deposits a machine-readable e-copy of the published version/a final peer-reviewed manuscript accepted for publication in institutional/subject-based/Zenodo repository as soon as possible and at the latest on publication

or in journals that sell subscriptions and also offer the possibility of making individual articles openly accessible (hybrid journals)

**Aims and Scope**

Atmospheric Chemistry and Physics (ACP) is an international scientific journal dedicated to the publication and public discussion of high quality studies investigating the Earth's atmosphere and the underlying chemical and physical processes. It covers the altitude range from the land and ocean surface up to the turbopause, including the troposphere, stratosphere and mesosphere.

The main subject areas comprise atmospheric modelling, field measurements, remote sensing, and laboratory studies of gases, aerosols, clouds and precipitation, isotopes, radiation, dynamics, biosphere interactions, and hydrosphere interactions (for details see [Journal Subject Areas](#)). The journal scope is focused on studies with general implications for atmospheric science rather than investigations that are primarily of local or technical interest. The [manuscript types](#) considered for peer-reviewed publication are research articles, review articles, technical notes and commentaries/replies.

- foster and provide a lasting record of scientific discussion;
- maximise the effectiveness and transparency of scientific quality assurance;

- make scientific publications freely accessible.

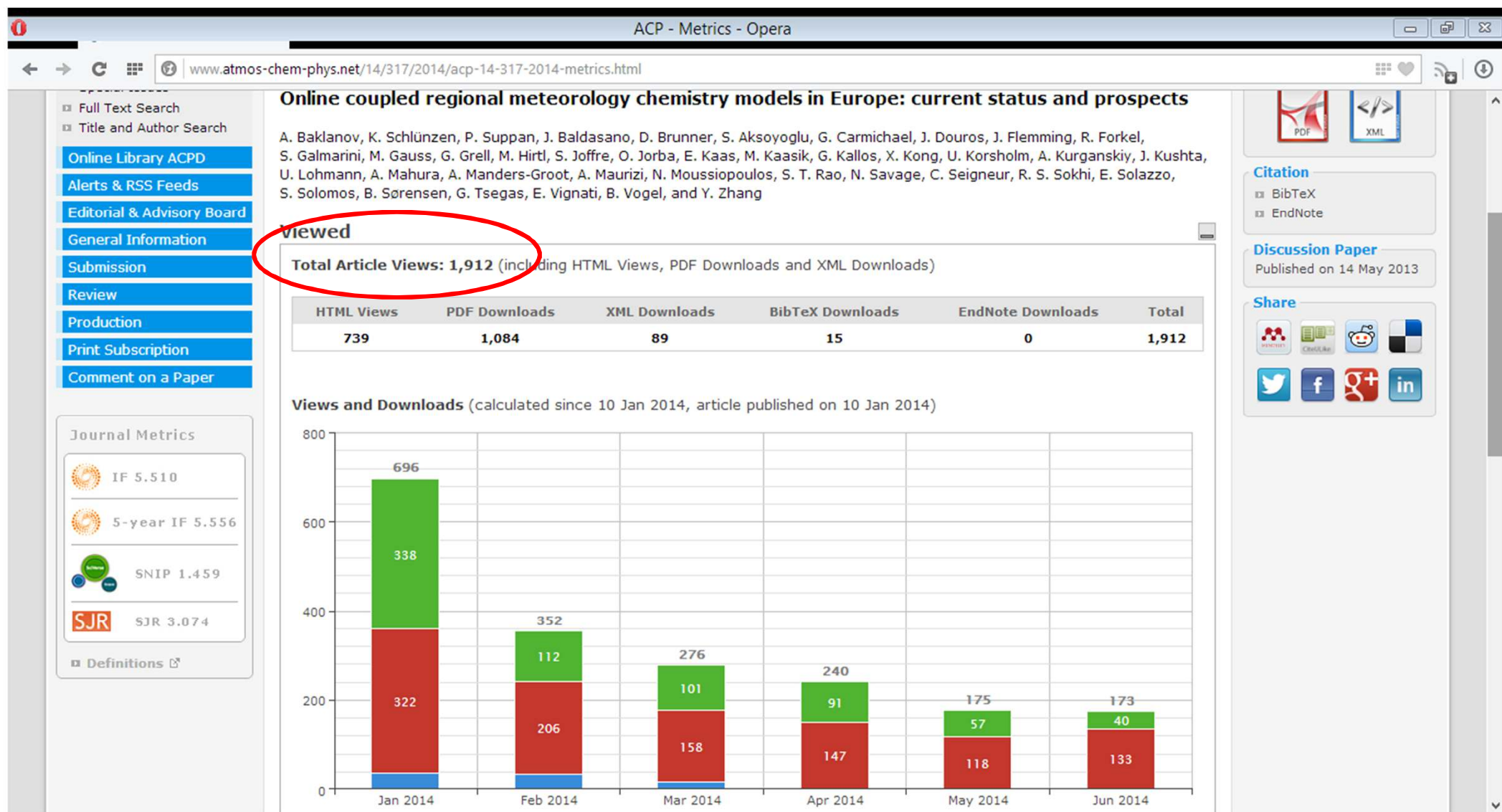


